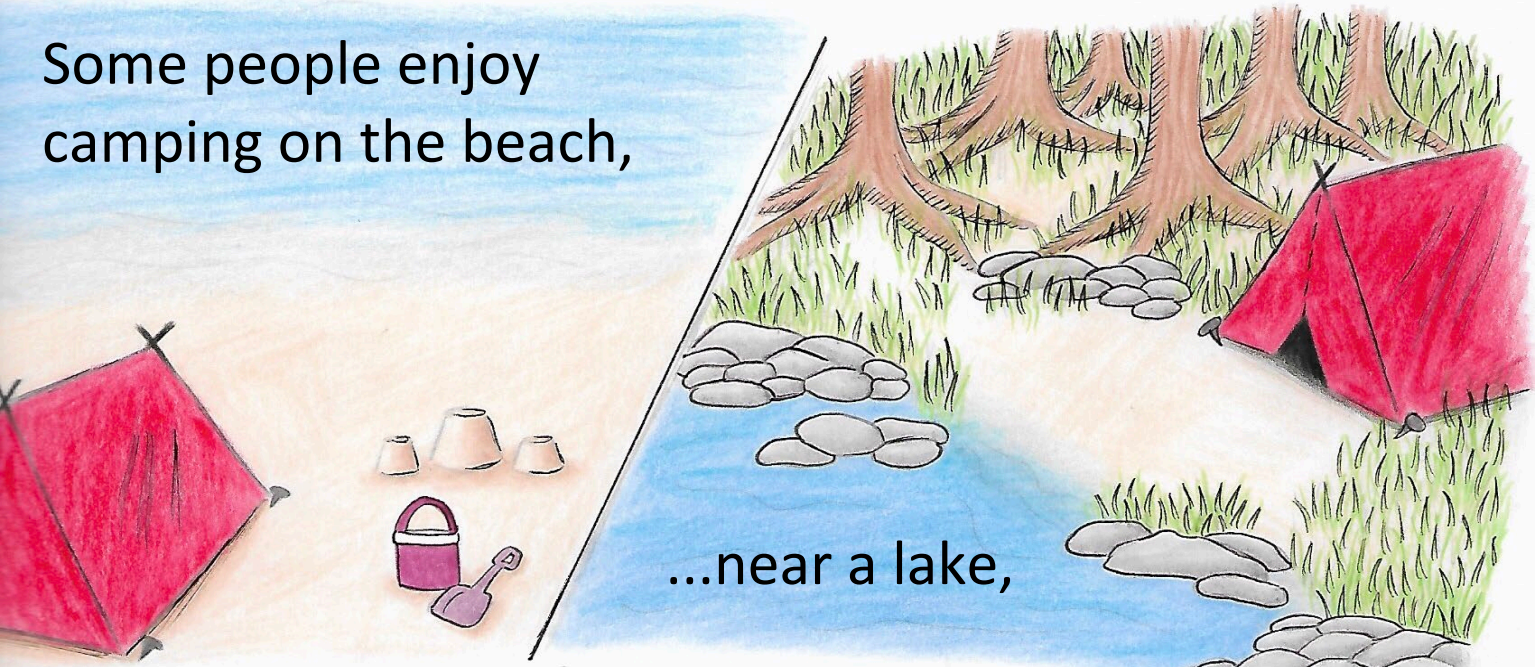


Hermano

camping on the beach,

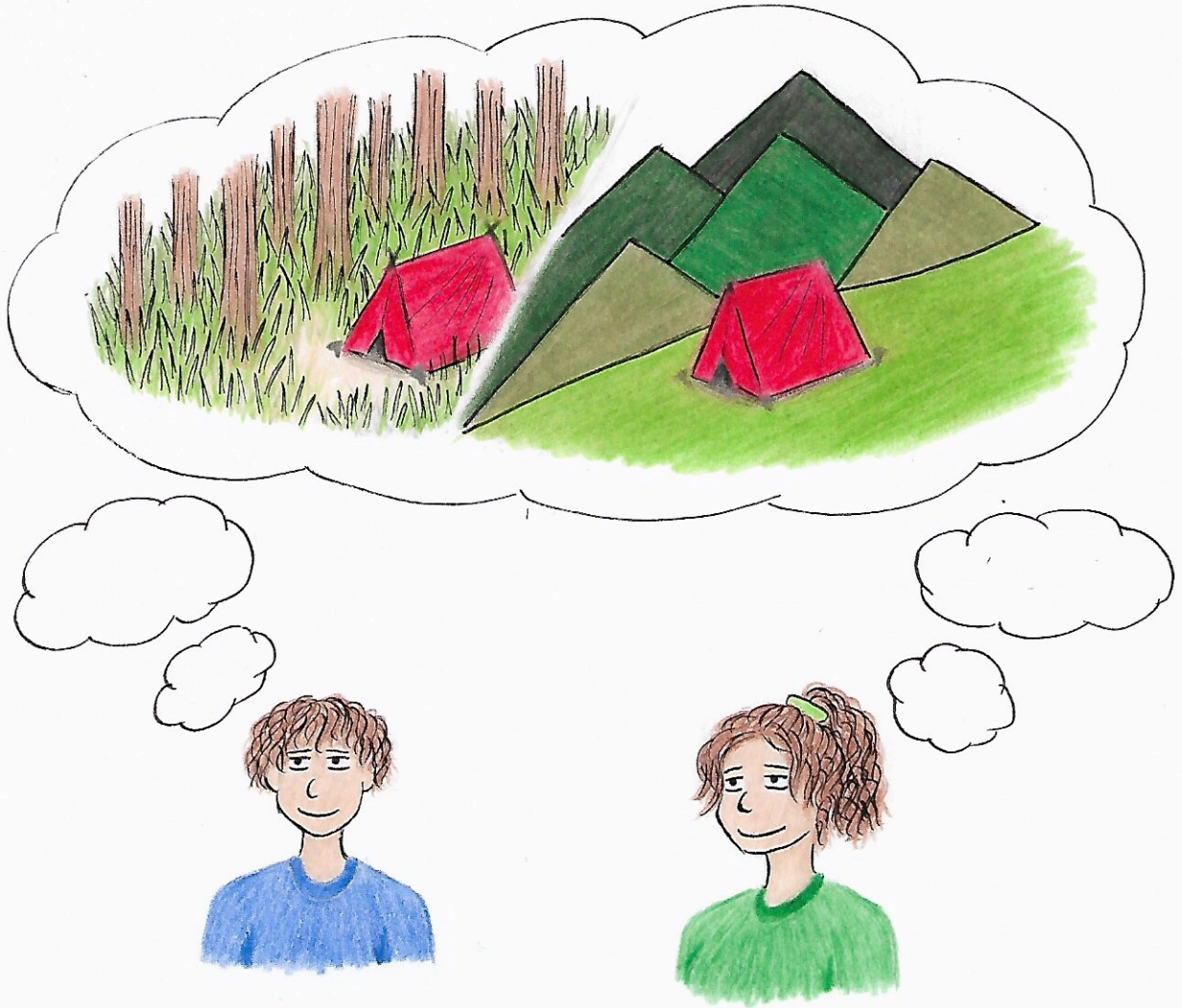


...near a lake,



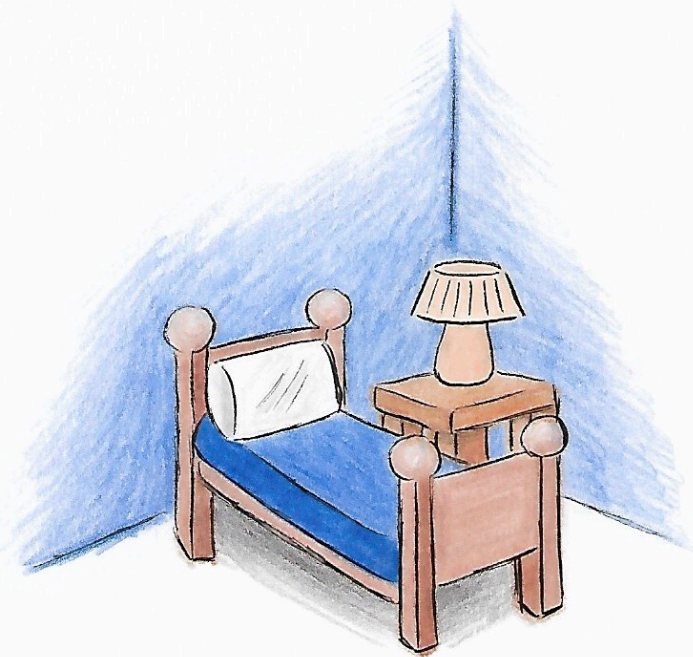
...or on their grandmother's inside patio.

When we go camping, the first thing that we do is walk for a few hours to try to find the perfect place to pitch our tent.



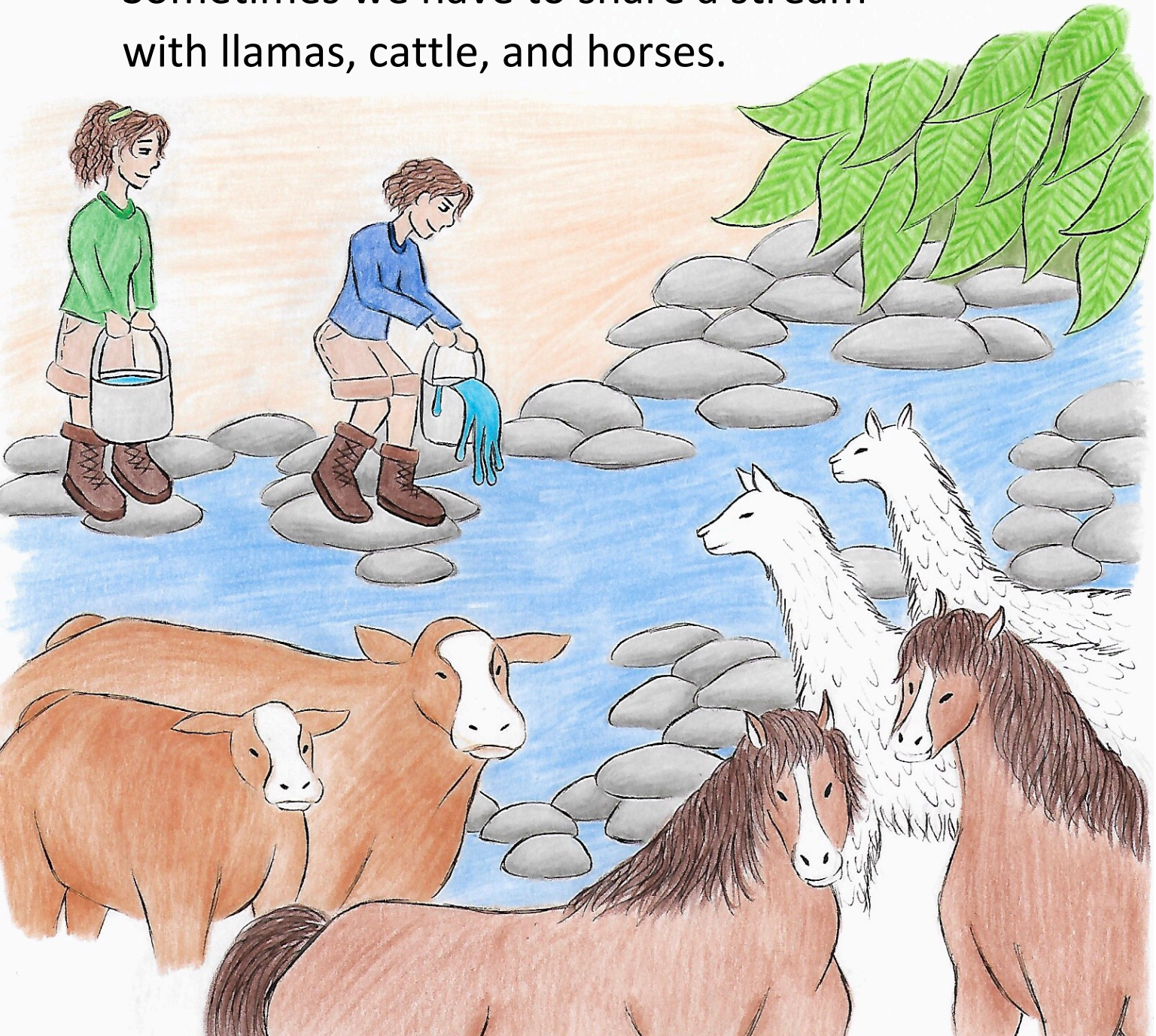
We camp in a place that's dry but also near a stream.



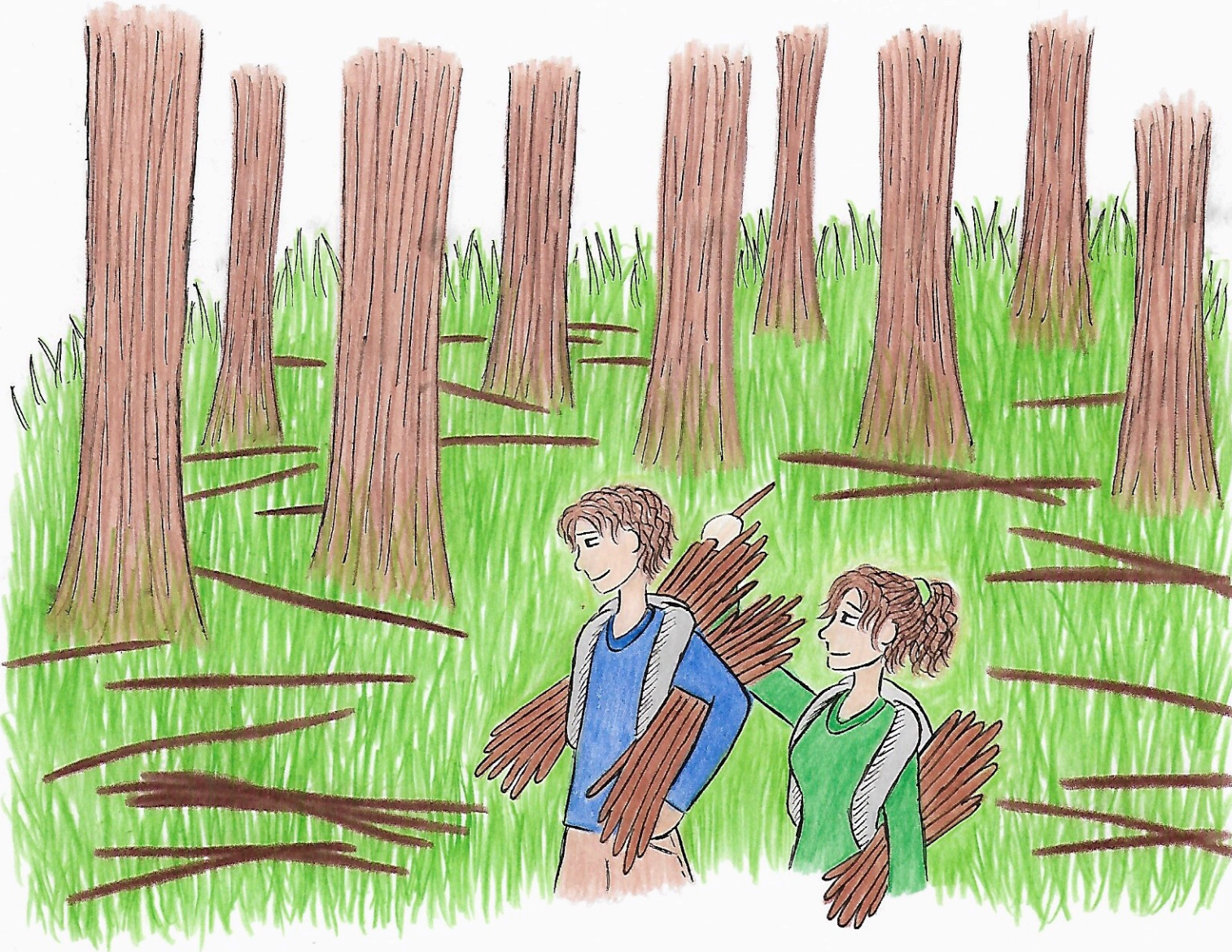
We use the water from the stream to cook.

Afterward, we look for wood to make a campfire.

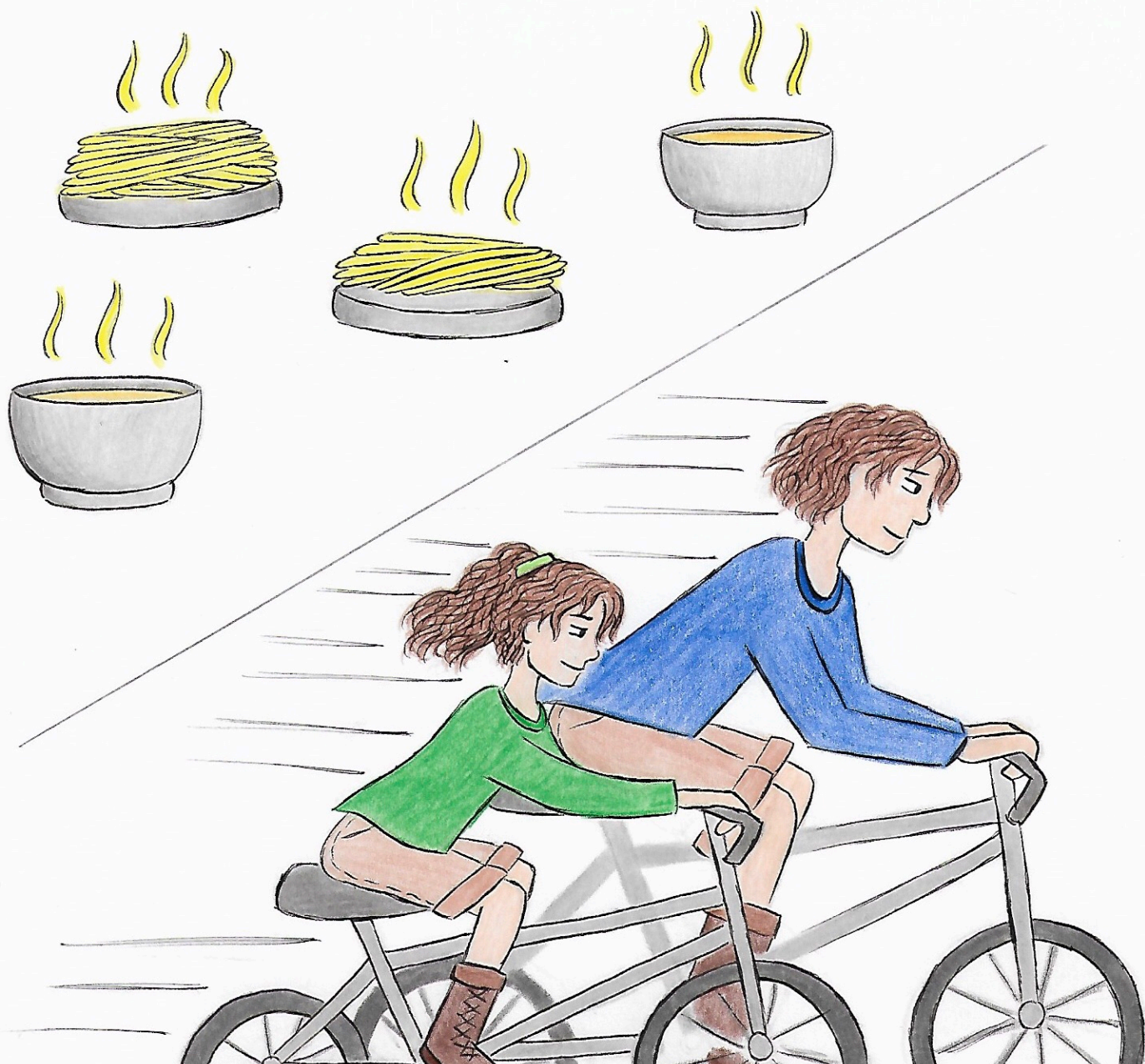


We need a fire to keep warm, and we use it to cook food.





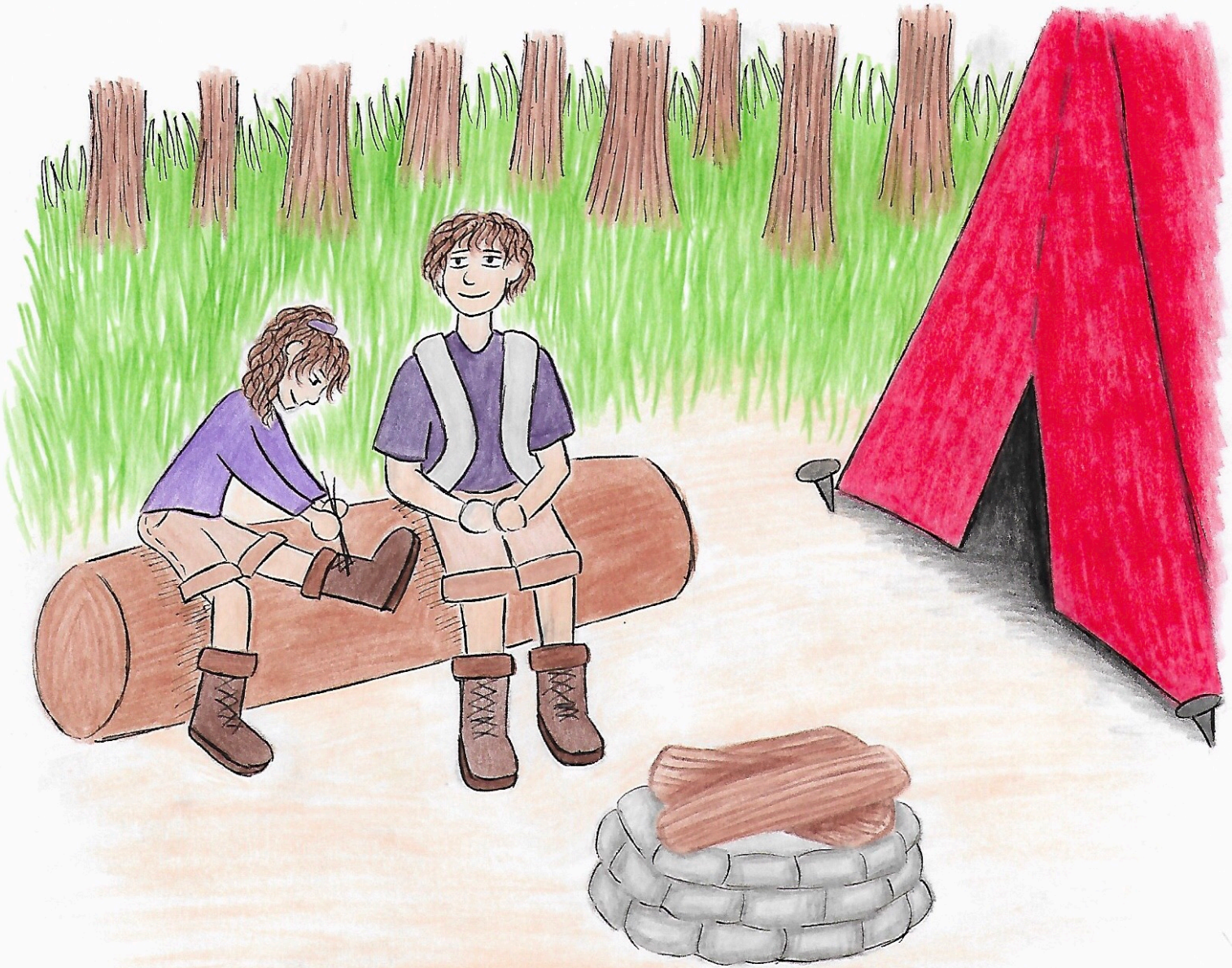
We like to prepare soups and pastas, which would give us the energy to go on a big hike.



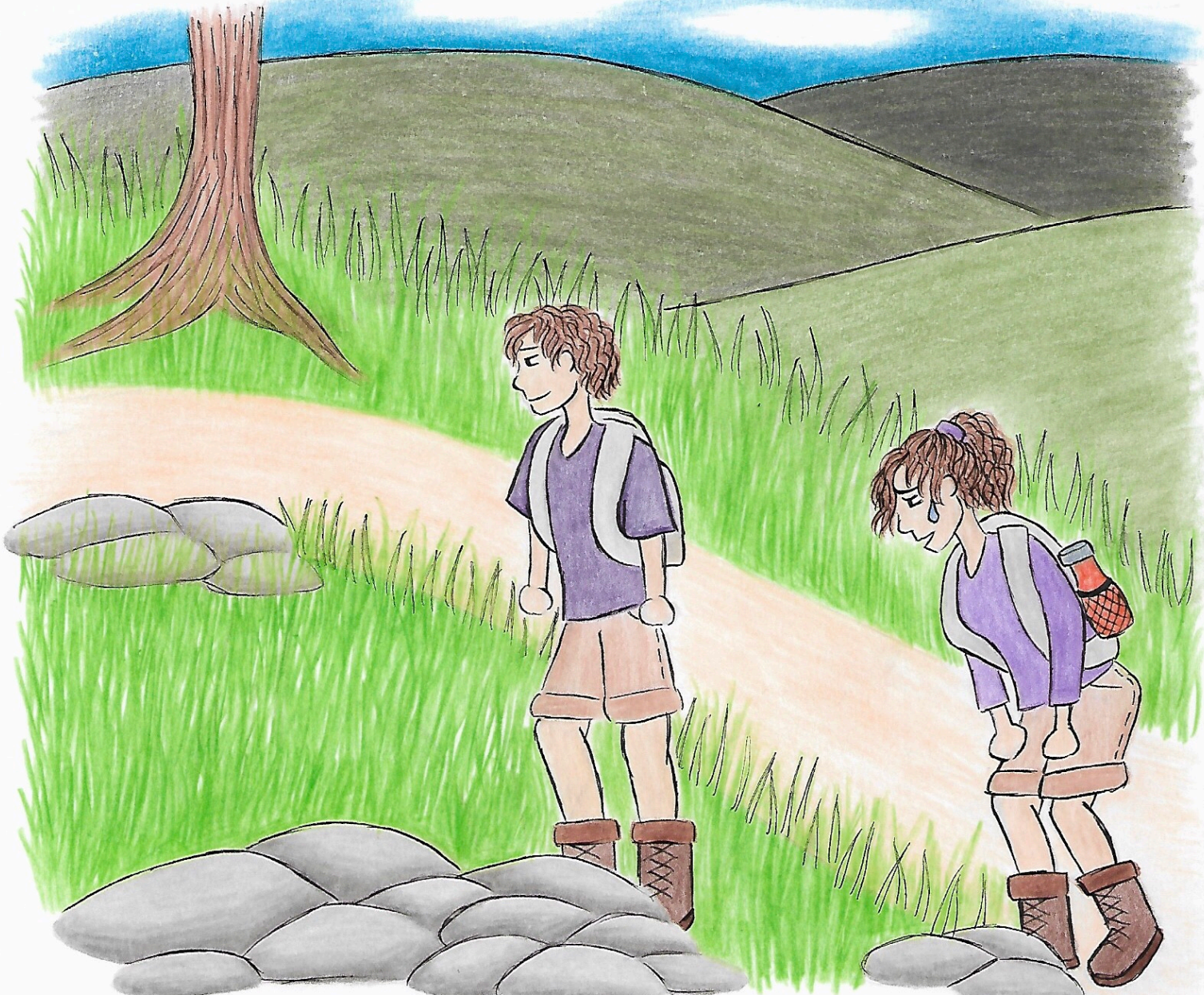
At night, we like to grill *angelitos*, a type of small fish, and tell stories under the stars.



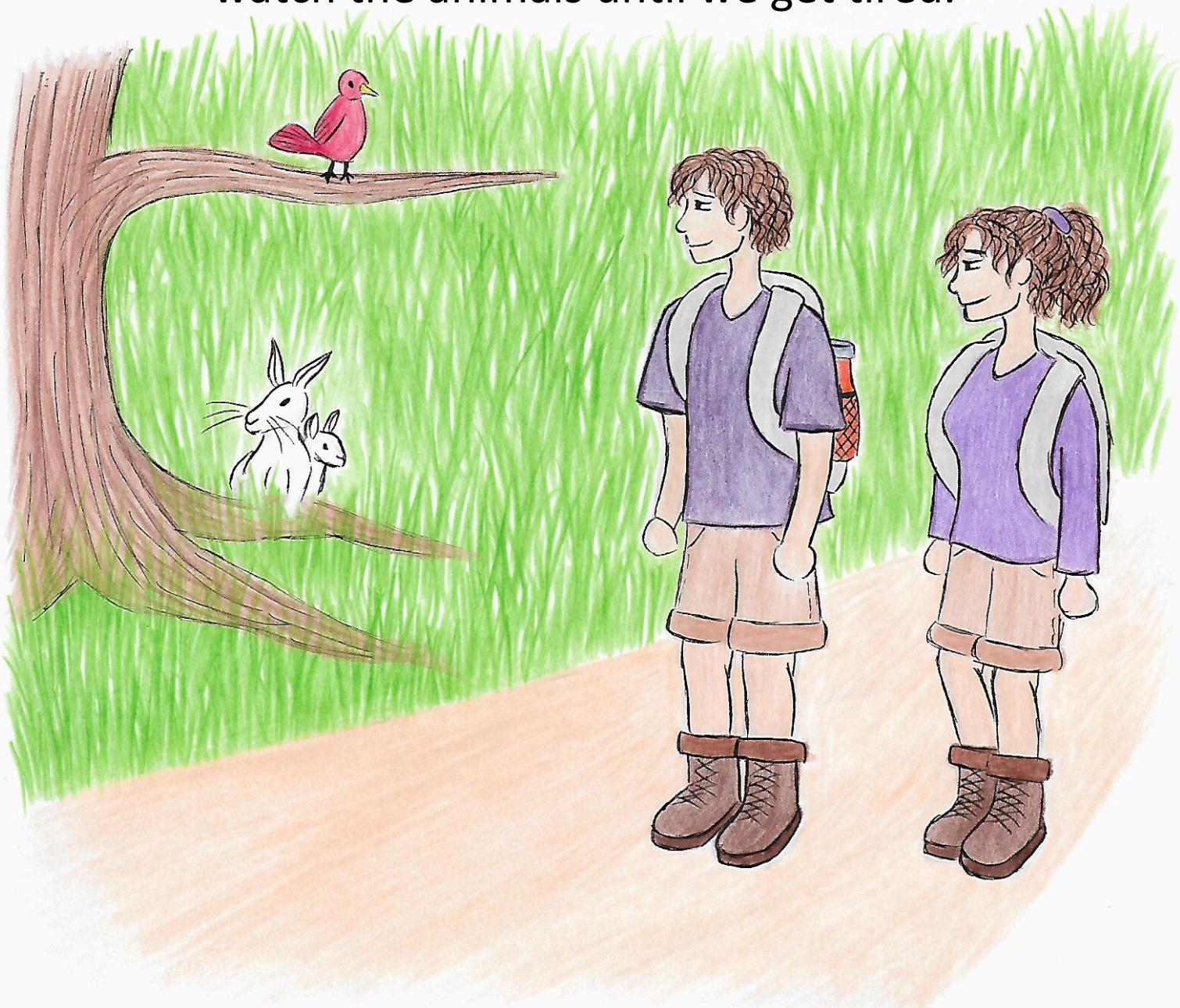
The following morning, we wake up early and put on our boots.



My brother is a better hiker than I am, but I love the challenge.



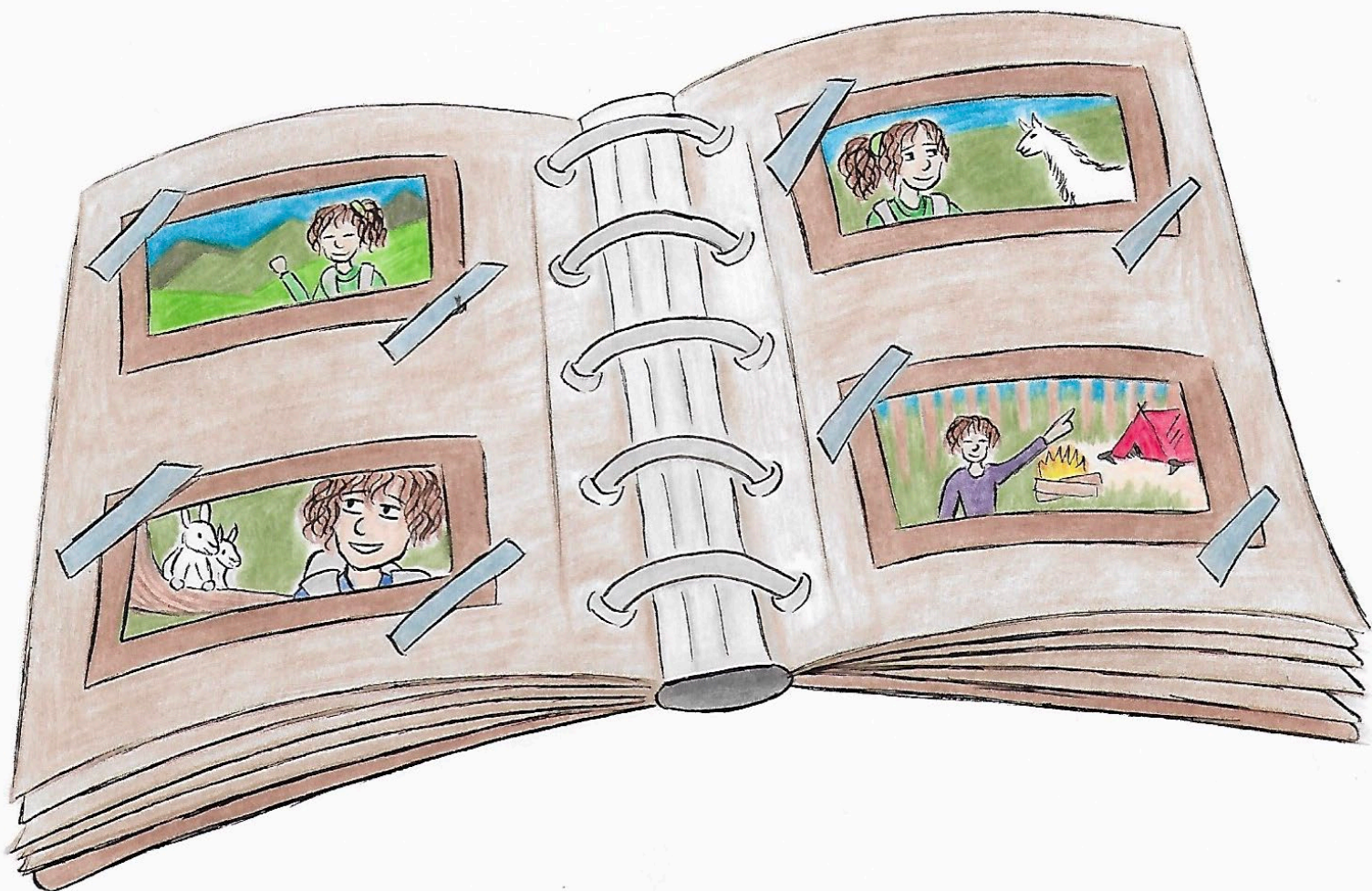
We walk through the mountains and watch the animals until we get tired.
